1) POLICE FAIR PRICE SHOP :- In order to provide food grains and cereals conveniently and at the reasonable price to the police men and their families a fair price shop has been opened at Police Head quarter, Chandrapur from Police Welfare Fund.

2) POLICE WELFARE SCHOOL :- Modernized school has been opened at Police head quarter with fully modernized and furnished school having a children garden and experienced teachers. At present **200** Children are enrolled within school. Presently Nursery, KG-I and KG-II, 1st Standard to Xth Standard (English Medium) and Balwadi (Marathi Medium) to STD X th are functioning.

3) DISH ANTENA FACILITY :- Dish antenna facilities have been made available to policemen, at Police Head quarter from Welfare fund at reasonable charges i.e. @ 100/- P.M. Priority has to be given quality reception and programs to them. This facilities is also utilized to give general instructions to police men at the time of emergency

A Colour television has been provided at Head quarter from 09/10/1984 and programmes are shown for entertainment to the police men and their families.

4)FLOOR MILL :- A floor mill is run from welfare fund at Police head quarters line Chandrapur for the convenience of families of policemen.

5) SPORTS :- Holly Ball, Caram Board, Chess board etc. have been provided to all police stations for playing and achieving proficiency in it and inculcate sportsmanship spirit amongst police men besides getting daily exercise.

6) POLICE MESS CANTEEN (COOKING GAS SYSTEMS) :-

There is a police mess and canteen at police head quarter Chandrapur to provides meal, refreshment etc. to recruits and police men. In the police mess meals are provided at the reasonable rates. Similarly in the canteen, Khara, Mitha, Tea etc. are made and provided to the police officers and men at reasonable rates. The mess and canteen run with the following staff as sanctioned by Government.

7) POLICE WELFARE HALL / MULTIPURPOSE HALL :-

Police welfare hall (Multipurpose hall) is constructed at Police head quarter from police welfare fund For giving facilities to police men for holding marriage ceremony and the cultural and social function. The same is being to publice too. The charges For the utilization of hall is Rs.10000/- Per day for private programmes. Priority is to be given to police men for utilizing the hall. The charges are fixed for this & Rs. 7000/- per day only .

8) COOKING GAS AGENCY :-

Distribution ship for cooking gas agency has been obtained. This agency being run from welfare fund for the convenience and betterment of the families of the police men. So far the gas connections have been provided to most of the police personnel.

9) POLICE PROVISION SHOP :-

In order to provided daily need articles provisions at the reasonable rates to the police men and their families. The provision shop has been opened at police head quarter lines Chandrapur from Police welfare fund. During the year woolen blankets and other seasonable articles are provided to the police men on installments basis through this shop.

10)LIBRARY AND NEWS PAPER :- Library has been fully equipped with books for all ages of children to elderly persons along with news papers / magazines at police head quarter and also lounge with television which has been provided.

1) POLICE FAIR PRICE SHOP :- In order to provide food grains and cereals conveniently and at the reasonable price to the police men and their families a fair price shop has been opened at Police Head quarter, Chandrapur from Police Welfare Fund.

2) POLICE WELFARE SCHOOL :- Modernized school has been opened at Police head quarter with fully modernized and furnished school having a children garden and experienced teachers. At present 375 children are enrolled within school. Presently Nursery, KG-I and KG-II, 1st Standard to Xth Standard (English Medium) and Balwadi (Marathi Medium) to STD X th are functioning.

3) SEWING CLASSES :- A sewing class is conducted at Police Head Quarter lines Chandrapur and family members of Police men (Ladies) are a parted in uniform stitching center. At present 20 ladies are working as tailoring.

4) DISH ANTENA FACILITY :- Dish antenna facilities have been made available to policemen, at Police Head quarter from Welfare fund at reasonable charges i.e. @ 100/- P.M. Priority has to be given quality reception and programs to them. This facilities is also utilized to give general instructions to police men at the time of emergency.

A Colour television has been provided at Head quarter from 09/10/1984 and programmes are shown for entertainment to the police men and their families.

5) CHILDREN PARK :- There are a children park at Police Head Quarter Chandrapur for the recreation of Police men's children.

6) FLOOR MILL :- A floor mill is run from welfare fund at Police head quarters line Chandrapur for the convenience of families of policemen.

7) SPORTS :- Holly Ball, Caram Board, Chess board etc. have been provided to all police stations for playing and achieving proficiency in it and inculcate sportsmanship spirit amongst police men besides getting daily exercise.

8) POLICE MESS CANTEEN (COOKING GAS SYSTEMS) :- There is a police mess and canteen at police head quarter Chandrapur to provides meal, refreshment etc. to recruits and police men. In the police mess meals are provided at the reasonable rates. Similarly in the canteen, Khara, Mitha, Tea etc. are made and provided to the police officers and men at reasonable rates. The mess and canteen run with the following staff as sanctioned by Government.

9) POLICE WELFARE HALL / MULTIPURPOSE HALL :- Police welfare hall (Multipurpose hall) is constructed at Police head quarter from police welfare fund for giving facilities to police men for holding marriage ceremony and the cultural and social functions. It is also utilized for holding crime conference, official meetings and also campus facilities of playing badminton to officer / police men and their children. This hall is also made available to private parties on hire. The charges for the utilization of this hall is Rs. 10000/- per day for private programmes. Priority is to be given to police men for utilizing the hall. The charges are fixed for this @ Rs. 7000/- per day only.

10) COOKING GAS AGENCY :-

Distribution ship for cooking gas agency has been obtained. This agency being run from welfare fund for the convenience and betterment of the families of the police men. So far the gas connections have been provided to most of the police personnel.

11) POLICE PROVISION SHOP :-

In order to provided daily need articles provisions at the reasonable rates to the police men and their families. The provision shop has been opened at police head quarter lines Chandrapur from Police welfare fund. During the year woolen blankets and other seasonable articles are provided to the police men on installments basis through this shop.

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12) LIBRARY AND NEWS PAPER :- Library has been fully equipped with books for all ages of children to elderly persons along with news papers / magazines at police head quarter and also lounge with television which has been provided.

Ballarsha cr.No.3029/06 u/s of UAPA Act.and were thoroughly interrogated.

The intelligence system has been developed through out the naxal affected area and various naxal operations are being performed to check the naxal activities effectively also a sharp look has been kept towards the activities of naxal front organizations to checks the naxal activities.

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4) INTERNAL ADMINISTRATION :- The staff position was satisfactory. The general discipline was satisfactory.

5) POLICE PUBLIC RELATIONS :- Police-public relations was very excellent. There was an easy access for public with the police and immediate cognizance of complaints was taken.
