After receiving the complaint, Durgapur Police started the investigation.Durgapur DB Squad and Special Squad headed by SDPO SushilkumarNayak were created to chase accused. Meanwhile, Police got the information that Accused Pratik alias Rahul DhanrajZade was wandering like a suspicious in Tukum area. On basis of the information received by them they kept watch on him and after getting concrete clue they took him in custody. He was questioned by them and he admitted to have stolen the vehicles. He was then arrested and taken to the Police station for further interrogation. After the completion of interrogation, he again admitted that he had stolen One car and three Motor cycles.

Car No. MH 34/S 1510, Motor Cycle No. MH 49/P 8599, MH 34/AD 4368, MH 40/AH 2485, MH 34/W 6287 which had been stolen earlier were recovered from him which estimated aroundRs. 10 Lac and Seventy Thousand.

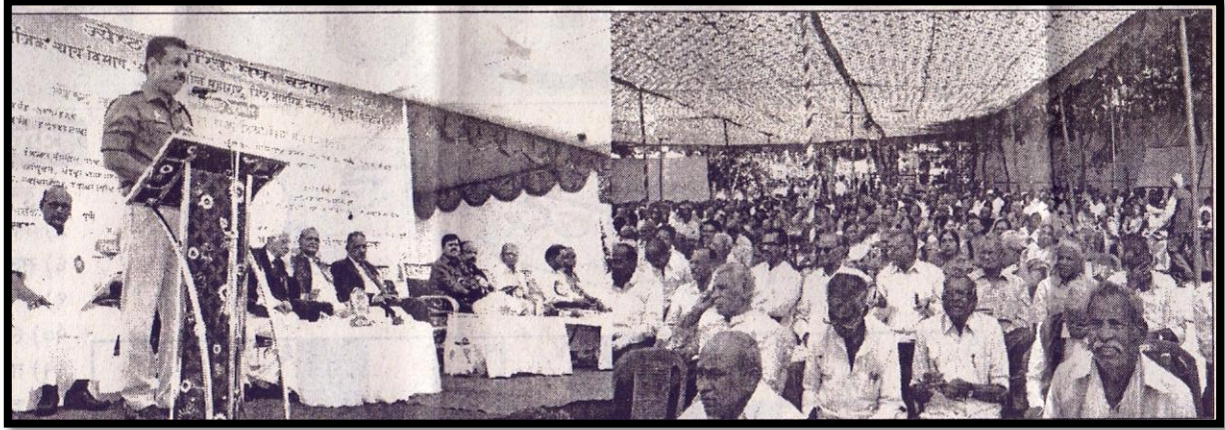
